

#### ● Essay Division

Then freely express your thoughts, actions you wish to take, and proposals to society. Although there are no minimum letter requirements, there is a maximum limit of 2000 letters

#### ● Illustration Division

Please submit a picture, illustration, painting, or graphics that freely expresses your thoughts regarding SDG's core principle of "Leaving No One Behind" in an A4 sized paper. (Submission is JPEG format)  
Maximum of 40 characters if letters are included.

#### ● AI Division

Please submit any work (Illustrations, Videos, Animations, Writings, etc.) that were made mainly with the use of AI regarding the theme "Leaving No One Behind". Although any format is accepted, please submit a work that can be viewed without the use of any special application or software. If any letters or audio are included in the work, please make sure they are in Japanese. Videos should be within 1 minute, while writings should be within 2000 letters. Please check specific guidelines regarding the use of generative AI.
